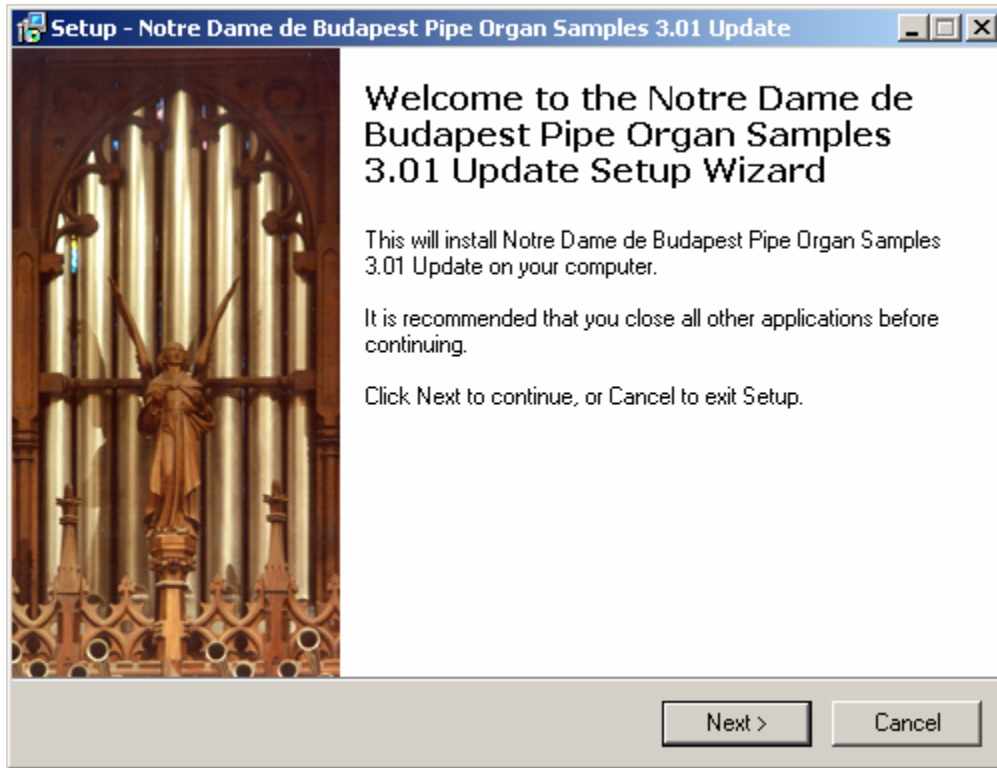

Currently, there are no updates available for the Compact Edition.

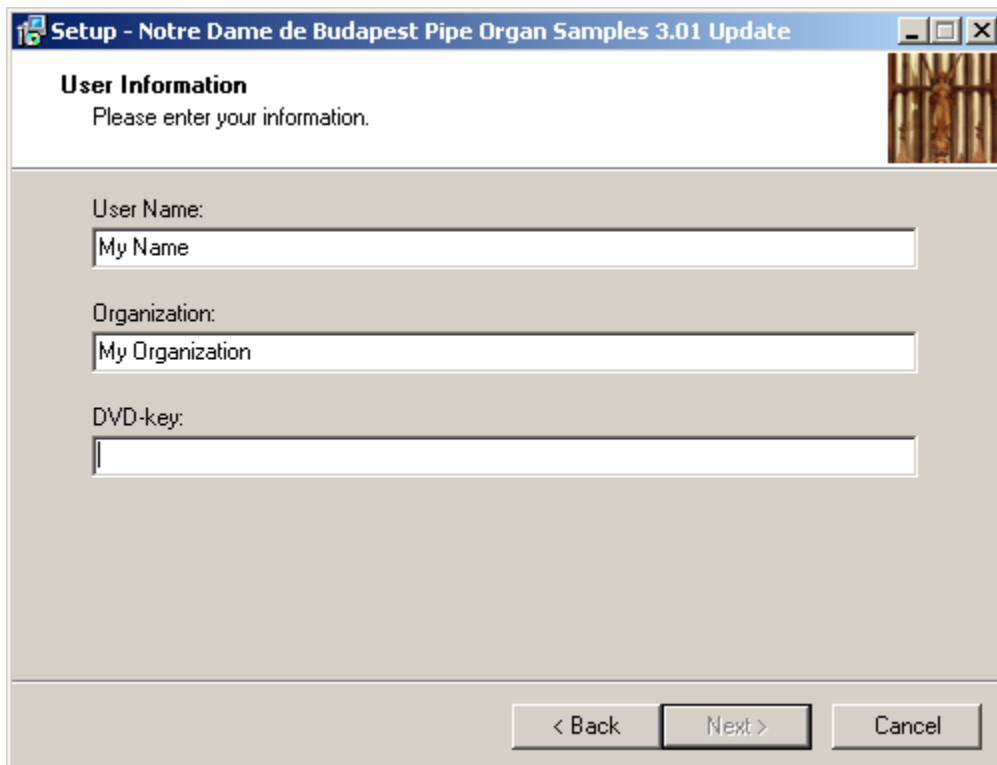
The update procedure

- Step 1 Login to the NDB Download Area (product registration required)
- Step 2 Download the update exe file you find there (*ndb_201_update.exe* or *ndb_301_update.exe*)
- Step 3 Launch the .exe file and follow the instructions you find there.



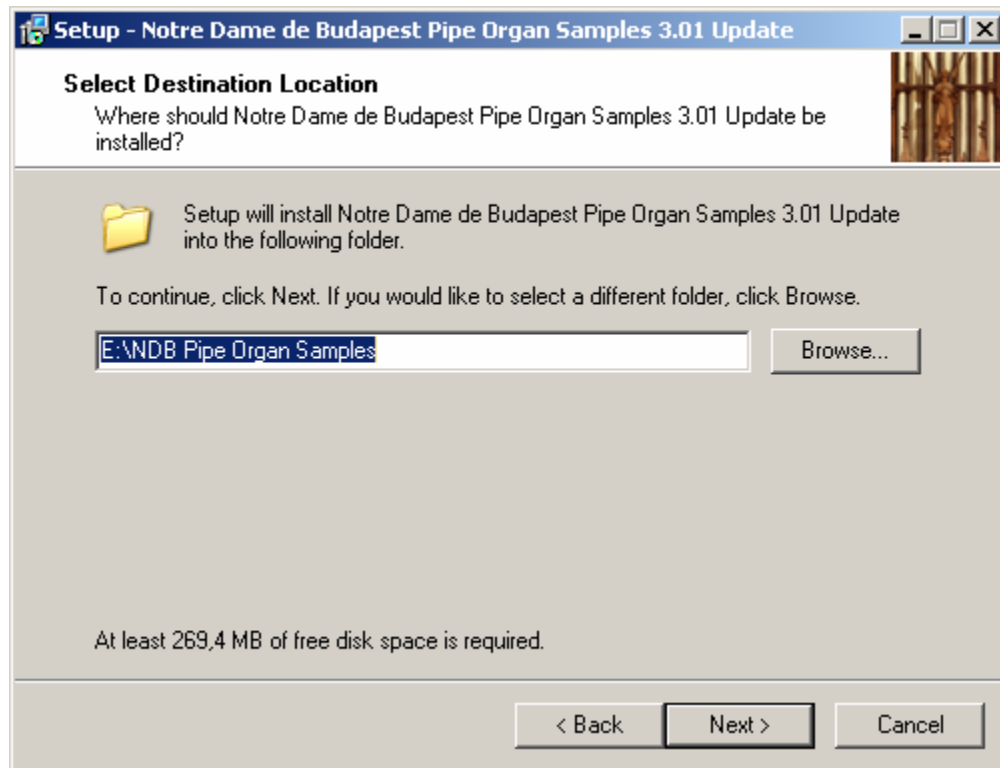
1 - Update setup wizard welcome page

- Step 4 Enter your current DVD-key (you will find in the jewel case of the DVDs)
 Make sure you enter it with the dashes.



2 - Enter you DVD-key to proceed

Step 5 Locate the folder of you current NDB installation and then click Next.



3 - Select the folder where you installed NDB previously

Step 6 The setup wizard may ask whether to replace the files it finds there. Answer 'Yes' in order to finish the update process successfully.

Step 7 Click on Finish and your NDB is updated successfully to the latest version.
